Wednesday, September 22

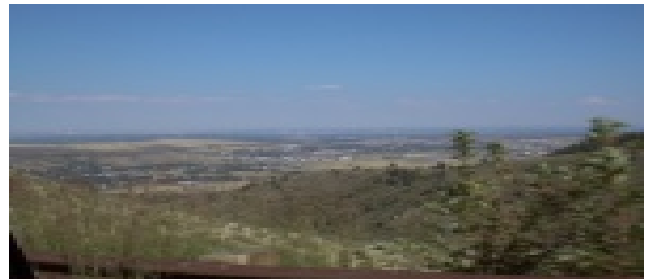
